IMPORTANT TO NOTE

- a) Applications are invited from eligible Indian Citizens for appointment as Local Bank Officer in Bank of Baroda. The selected candidates shall be posted in the applied State only.
- b) The process of Registration of application is complete only when fee is deposited with the Bank through On-line mode on or before the last date for fee payment. Candidates are requested to note down the score/registration number and a copy of application form for their future reference.
- c) Before applying, candidates should ensure that they fulfill all the eligibility criteria for the post as on the date of eligibility.
- d) Shortlisting and interview / selection round will be purely provisional without verification of documents. Candidates will be subject to verification of all details/documents with the original as and when called by the Bank.
- e) Candidates are advised to check Bank's website (Current Opportunities) regularly for details and updates. All revisions/corrigendum/modifications (if any) will be posted on the Bank's website only.
- f) All correspondence, including Call letters/ Interview Dates/advice, wherever required, will be made only on the email ID mentioned by the candidate in their online application form and the same has to be kept open till completion of the recruitment process.
- g) Post qualification experience below 8 months in any organization & Experience in Central cadre would not be considered.

Employees of Bank of Baroda who have resigned from an officer-grade position or exited from the Bank while serving on contract within the last three years as on the cut-off date are not eligible to apply.

Employees working in Bank of Baroda on officer cadre or employees engaged on contract basis will not be eligible to apply.

Prior experience will not be considered for any service seniority.

A candidate can apply for one State only, and no more than one application should be submitted by any candidate. In case of multiple applications only the latest valid (completed) application will be retained and the application fee/registration charges paid for the other multiple registration(s) will stand forfeited. Candidature of the applicant will be considered only against the vacancies in the State for which he/she has applied. Special list will be drawn State wise and category wise.

Abbreviations stand for: SC - Scheduled Caste, ST - Scheduled Tribe, OBC - Other Backward Classes, EWS - Economically Weaker Sections, UR - Unreserved, PWD - Persons with Disability, OC - Other Caste, Chhargod, HI - Hearing Impaired, VI - Visually Impaired, ID - Intellectually Disabled

NOTE:

- Please note that change of category submitted by the applicant will not be permitted at any stage after registration of online application.
- Candidates belonging to OBC category, not coming in the 'Creamy Layer' and/or if their caste does not find place in the Central List are not entitled to OBC reservation and age relaxation. They should indicate their category as 'GENERAL' or 'GENERAL (SC, ST, PWD) as applicable.
- Benefit of reservation under EWS category is available only upon production of an 'Income and Asset Certificate' issued by a Competent Authority in the format prescribed.
- Caste, EWS/PWD certificate issued by Competent Authority in format prescribed by the Government of India will have to be submitted by the candidates applying under SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PWD category, while submitting their application/s.
- The number of vacancies including reserved vacancies mentioned above are provisional and may vary according to the actual requirements of the Bank.
- Reservation for PWD is horizontal and within the overall vacancies for the post.
- Candidates seeking age relaxation will be required to submit copies of necessary certificate(s) at the time of interview and at any subsequent stage of the recruitment process as required by Bank.
- There is no reservation for Ex-servicemen in Officers' Cadre.
- Maximum age indicated is for General category candidates as on 11.07.2025. Selection in upper age limit will be available as detailed below.

The aforesaid Relaxation of Upper Age is applicable as per the Reservation Points available as mentioned above.

4. Experience (Post Mandatory Educational Qualification) as on 01.07.2025:

Minimum 1 year experience (Post Mandatory Educational Qualification Experience) as an officer in any Scheduled Commercial Bank or any Regional Rural Bank as listed in Second Schedule of Reserve Bank of India. Experience in NBFCs, cooperative banks, Payment Banks, Small Finance Banks or FinTech will not be considered. Candidates shall have to submit job profile certified by their existing/ previous employer(s) with whom they are/were employed. In case their job profile does not match substantially or is different than the job profile of a Scale-I officer of Bank of Baroda then the application of such candidate will be summarily rejected at any stage of the recruitment process. Decision of the Bank in this regard would be final and binding on all candidates. No representation or correspondence will be entertained by the Bank in this regard.

5. Application fee:

- Rs.350/- (Inclusive of GST) + Payment Gateway Charges for General, EWS & OBC candidates
- Rs.175/- (Inclusive of GST) + Payment Gateway Charges for SC, ST, PWD, EWS (Ex-Servicemen) & Women

The candidate is required to pay the non-refundable application fee/verification charge irrespective of whether online test is conducted or not and even if the candidate is shortlisted or not for the interview.

6. Location of Posting:

The selected candidates will be posted within the State for which they apply for the first 12 years of their service or upon their promotion to SNCS-TV Grade, whichever is earlier. Thereafter, they are liable to be posted by the Bank at its absolute discretion to any of the Branches/ Office of the Bank or to any place in India.

One advance increment shall be granted to the selected candidates for work experience of one (1) year or more as an Officer in a Scheduled Commercial Bank or any Regional Rural Bank as listed in Second Schedule of Reserve Bank of India. However, prior experience will not be considered for any further increment.

8. **Credit History:** The candidate applying for the above posts shall ensure that they maintain a healthy Credit history and shall have a minimum CIBIL score of 650 or above at the time of joining. The minimum credit score will be as per the Bank's policy, extended from time to time. Candidates with record of default in repayment of loans/credit card dues and/ or against whom credit adverse report of CIBIL or other external agencies are available are not eligible for appointment. The Bank reserves the right to disqualify candidates with an unsatisfactory credit profile.

9. Probation Period:

The selected candidate will be on probation for a period of 12 months (12) month of active service from the date of his/ her joining the Bank.

10. Service Bond

Selected candidates will be required to mandatorily execute a Service Bond as under:

"Serve for a minimum period of 3 (Three) years in the Bank after joining the service or upon the Bank's extension of its State/Go. Five Years bond after applicable as per Government rules in case he/she leaves the Bank before completion of 3 years of active service."

11. Eligibility Criteria

Candidates intending to apply for the said post should ensure that they fulfil the minimum eligibility criteria specified:

Please note that the eligibility criteria specified herein are the basic criteria for applying for the post. Candidates must necessarily produce the relevant documents pertaining to category, nationality, age, educational qualifications, work experience etc. in original along with a photocopy thereof in support of their identity and eligibility as indicated in the online application form at the time of interview and /or any subsequent stage of the recruitment process as required by the Bank. Please note that no change of category will be permitted at any stage after registration of the online application and the result will be processed considering the category which has been indicated in the online application, subject to guidelines of the Government of India in this regard. Merely applying for the said post/ appearing for and being shortlisted in the Online examination and/ or in the subsequent GD/ interview and/ subsequent processes does not imply that a candidate will necessarily be offered employment in the Bank. No request for considering the candidature under any category other than in which applied will be entertained.

Note:

- All the educational qualifications mentioned should be from a recognized University/ Institute/ Board recognized by Govt of India, approved by Govt. Regulatory Bodies. Proper document from Board/ University / Regulatory Body has to be submitted at the time of application / interview / as and when called for by the Bank. The date of passing the examination which is recognised for eligibility will be the date of passing appearing on the main sheet/ provisional certificate issued by the University/Institute.
In case the result of a particular examination is posted on the website of the University/ Institute and web based certificate is issued then a certificate in original issued by the appropriate authority of the University/ Institute indicating the date of passing properly mentioned thereon will be reckoned for verification and for further process.
- Candidates should indicate the percentage obtained in Graduation/Post Graduation calculated to the nearest one decimal in the online application. Where CGPA/ OGPA is awarded, the same should be converted into percentage and indicate the same in online application. If called for interview, the candidate will have to produce a certificate issued by the appropriate authority indicating the points of the University regarding conversion of grade into percentage and the percentage of marks scored by the candidate in terms of marks.
- Calculation of Percentage:** The percentage of marks unless mentioned by the University/ Board, shall be arrived at, by dividing the total marks obtained by the candidate in all the subjects in all semester(s)/ year(s) by aggregate maximum marks in all the subjects (independent of Honours/ optional/ additional optional subject, if any, multiplied by 100. This will be applicable for those Universities also where class/ grade is decided on the basis of Honours marks only. The fraction of percentage as arrived will be ignored, i.e. 58.99% will be treated as less than 59% and 54.99% will be treated as less than 55%.

12. Nationality / Citizenship (as on 01.07.2023)

A candidate must be either (i) a Citizen of India or (ii) a subject of Nepal or (iii) subject of Bhutan or (iv) a Tibetan refugee who came over to India before 1st January 1962 with the intention of permanently settling in India or (v) a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African Countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia and Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India.

Provided that a candidate belonging to categories (i), (ii), (iii) & (iv) above shall be a person in whose favour a certificate of eligibility has been issued by the Government of India. A candidate in whose case a certificate of eligibility is necessary may be admitted to the examination/ interview conducted by the Bank but on final selection, the offer of appointment may be given only after the Government of India has issued the necessary eligibility certificate to him.

1.7 Selection Procedures

- The selection process comprises of online test, psychometric test or any other test deemed suitable for further selection process followed by Group Discussion and/or Interview of candidates, qualifying in the online test.
- However, if the number of eligible applications received is large /less, then Bank reserves the right to change the shortlisting criteria/Interview process. Bank may, at its discretion, consider conducting of Multiple Choice/Descriptive / Psychometric Test / Group Discussion/Interview or any other selection/shortlisting methodologies for the above position.
- Merely satisfying the eligibility norms does not entitle a candidate to be called for interview. Bank reserves the right to call only the requisite number of candidates for the interview after preliminary screening/shortlisting with reference to the candidate's qualifications, availability, experience etc.

1.1.1 Online Test

The tentative structure of the online examination will be as follows:

- The above Sections / Tests except the Test of English Language will be available bilingual i.e. English and Hindi. There will be separate timing for every section.
- The minimum qualifying marks/percentage of marks in each of the section would be 40% for General & ENS Category and 35% for Reserved Categories. However, the Bank reserves the right to change the minimum / value of qualifying criteria at its sole discretion.
- Candidates marks of Section 1,2,3 and 4 shall be reckoned for drawing the merit list shortlisting the candidates for participation in further selection process and drawing the rank list. There will be penalty for wrong answers in all sections. For each question for which a wrong answer has been given by the candidate, 1/3 of the mark assigned to that question will be deducted as penalty to arrive at corrected score. If a question is left blank i.e. no answer is given by the candidate, there will be no penalty for that question.

As part of the selection process, candidates will be required to undergo a psychometric assessment. This evaluation is designed to determine the candidate's alignment with the Core Values of Bank of Canada and to assess their aptitude for sales-related roles. Preference will be given to candidates who demonstrate a strong alignment with the Bank's core values and exhibit a natural flair for sales. Bank reserves the right to modify the structure of the examination including addition / subtraction by the way of describing test case study which will be initiated through its website.

The date of online test shall be advised separately. Other detailed information, form, regarding the examination will be given in an information hand out which will be made available for the candidates to download along with the call letters from the Bank's official website.

1.1.2 Guidelines for Persons With Benchmark Disabilities/Specific Disability using the services of a Scribe

The scribe will be allowed to be used as per the guidelines issued vide Office Memorandum F.No. 18-110/1003-00/II dated February 26, 2013 of Government of India, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Department of Disability Affairs, New Delhi and clarification issued by Government of India, Ministry of Finance, Department of Financial Services vide letter F. No. 1/1/2013- Welfare dated 24.04.2013, Office Memorandum F.No. 24-02/2015-30-III dated 29.08.2016 of Government of India, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (Discharge) and F. No. 24-6/2019-30-III dated 10.08.2021. In all such cases where a scribe is used, the following rules will apply:

- For candidates availing scribe as accorded with OM - F. No. 24-6/2019-30-III dated 10.08.2021 shall be allowed scribe facility subject to production of a certificate at the time of online examination to the effect that person concerned has limitation to write and that scribe is essential to write examination on his/her behalf from competent medical authority of a Government hospital/ institution as per proforma attached as Appendix I. Such candidates shall also upload their certificate while filling the applications form.
- The visually impaired candidates and candidates whose writing speed is adversely affected permanently for any reason can use their own scribe at their cost during the online examination.
- The candidate will have to arrange his / her own scribe at his /her own cost.
- The scribe should be from an academic stream different from that regulated for the post.
- Both the candidate as well as scribe will have to give a suitable undertaking confirming that the scribe fulfils all the stipulated eligibility criteria for a scribe mentioned above. Further in case it later transpires that he/she did not fulfil any laid down eligibility criteria or suppressed material facts the candidature of the applicant will stand cancelled, irrespective of the result.
- These candidates who use a scribe shall be eligible for compensatory time of 20 minutes or otherwise advised for every hour of the examination.
- The scribe arranged by the candidate should not be a candidate for the online examination. If violation of the above is detected at any stage of the process, candidature of both the candidate and the scribe will be cancelled. Candidates eligible for and who wish to use the services of a scribe in the examination should invariably carefully indicate the same in the online application form. Any subsequent request may not be favourably entertained.
- Only candidates registered for compensatory time will be allowed such concessions since compensatory time given to candidates shall be system based, it shall not be possible to allow such time if he / she is not registered for the same. Candidates not registered for compensatory time shall not be allowed such concessions.
- During the examination, at any stage, if it is found that scribe is independently answering / solving the questions himself, the examination session for such candidate will be terminated, and candidate's candidature will be cancelled. The candidature of such candidates using the services of a scribe will also be cancelled if it is reported after the examination by the test administrator personnel that the scribe independently answered the questions.

12.3 Guidelines for candidates with locomotor disability and cerebral palsy

Compensatory time of 25 minutes per hour or otherwise advised shall be permitted for the candidates with locomotor disability and cerebral palsy where document (writing) competency is affected in the aspect of slowing the performance of functions (minimum of 40% impairment).

12.4 Guidelines for Visually Impaired candidates

- Visually Impaired candidates (who suffer from not less than 40% of disability) may opt to view the contents of the test in magnified font and all such candidates will be eligible for compensatory time of 20 minutes for every hour or otherwise advised of examination.
- The facility of viewing the contents of the test in magnifying font will not be available to Visually Impaired candidates who use the services of a Scribe for the examination.
- These guidelines are subject to change in terms of OGI guidelines/ clarifications, if any, from time to time.

12.5 Examination Centres for Online Test/ GD/ Interview or any other method of selection

- i. Online test will be held at the following centres, which shall depend on the number of applications received, administrative feasibility or specific requirements of the bank;
- ii. The list of Center for Online Examination is enclosed in Annexure III.
- iii. The examination may be held at the following centres and the address of the centre will be advised in the call letters. Bank, however, reserves the right to cancel any of the Examination Centres and/ or add some other Centres, as its discretion, depending upon the response, administrative feasibility, etc. Bank also reserves the right to allot the candidate to any centre other than the one he, she has opted for.
- iv. Centres for GD/ Interview will be located at a later date keeping in view the administrative feasibility.
- v. No request for change of Centre for Examination / Interview will be entertained.
- vi. Candidate will appear for the examination, interview at the respective centres at his/her own risk and expense and Bank will not be responsible for any injury or losses etc. of any nature.
- vii. Any unruly behavior/misbehavior in the examination hall/Interview Centre may result in cancellation of candidature/ disqualification from this exam and also from future exams conducted by the Bank.

12.6 Biometric Data – Capturing and Verification:

It has been decided to capture and verify the biometric data (right thumb impression or otherwise) /IRIS Scan and the photograph of the candidates on the day of the Online Examination.

Please note: The biometric data / IRIS scan and photograph will be captured / verified on the following occasions –

- ▶ Before the start of the online examination it will be captured.
- ▶ At the end of online examination before leaving the computer hall / lab.
- ▶ At the time of joining the Group Discussion / Interview etc.
- ▶ At the time of joining the Bank for selected candidates.
- ▶ At any other time, as/when as decided by the Bank.

Decision of the Biometric data / IRIS scan data verification authentic with regard to its status (matched or mismatched) shall be final and binding upon the candidates. Refusal to participate in the process of biometric / IRIS scan data capturing / verification on any of the above mentioned occasions may lead to cancellation of candidature.

Candidates are requested to take care of the following points in order to ensure a smooth process.

- ▶ If Fingers are cracked (stained ink, washed/coloured etc), ensure to thoroughly wash them so that coating is completely removed before the exam / interview / joining day.
- ▶ If Fingers are dirty or dusty, ensure to wash them and dry them before the finger print (biometric) is captured.
- ▶ Ensure Fingers of both hands are dry. If Fingers are moist, wipe each finger to dry them.
- ▶ If the primary finger (right thumb) to be captured is injured/ damaged, immediately notify the concerned authority in the test centre. In such cases impression of other fingers, may not may be captured.

12.7 Action Against Candidates Found Guilty of Misconduct/ Use Of Unfair Means

Candidates are advised in their own interest that they should not furnish any particulars that are false, tampered with or fabricated and **should not** supply any material information while submitting online application.

At the time of examination/ GD/ Interview or in a subsequent selection procedure, if a candidate is (or has been) found guilty of –

- i. Using unfair means or
- ii. Impersonating or procuring impersonation by any person or
- iii. Misbehaving in the examination/ interview hall or disclosing, publishing, reproducing, transmitting, storing or facilitating transmission and storage of contents of the test(s) or any information therein in whole or part thereof in any form or by any means, verbal or written, electronically or mechanically for any purpose or
- iv. Resorting to any irregular or improper means in connection with his/ her candidature or
- v. Obtaining support for his/ her candidature by unfair means, or
- vi. Carrying mobile phones or similar electronic devices of communication in the examination/ interview hall, then such a candidate may, in addition to rendering himself/ herself liable to criminal prosecution, be liable:
 - a. To be disqualified from the examination for which he/ she is a candidate
 - b. To be debarred either permanently or for a specified period from any examination conducted by Bank
 - c. For termination of service, if he/ she has already joined the Bank.

Important: The test conducting agency, would be analyzing the responses (answers) of individual candidates with other candidates in detect patterns of similarity of right and wrong answers. If in the analytical procedure adopted by test conducting agency in this regard, it is inferred/

concluded that the responses have been shared and scores obtained are not genuine/ valid, in such cases Bank reserves the right to cancel the candidature of the concerned candidate and the result of such candidature (disqualify) will be withheld.

11.8 Use of Mobile Phones, Pagers, Calculator or Any Such Devices:

- Mobile phones, pagers or any other communication devices are not allowed inside the premises where the examination is being conducted. Any infringement of these instructions shall entail cancellation of candidature and disciplinary action including ban from future examinations.
- Candidates are advised in their own interest not to bring any of the banned items including mobile phones/ pagers to the venue of the examination, an arrangement for safekeeping cannot be assured.
- Candidates are not permitted to use or have in possession calculators in examination premises.

11.9 Language Proficiency Test (LPT)

- The candidate must have Proficiency (reading, writing and speaking) in the local language of the State applied for. Candidates shortlisted in the Online Examination will be required to qualify Language Proficiency test, failing which they will not be allowed to appear for Personal Interview and their candidature will not be considered for further selection process.
- However, candidates who produce 10th or 12th standard marksheet/certificate evidencing having studied the specified local language of the applied State as one of the subjects will not be required to undergo the language proficiency test.

11.10 Group Discussion (GD)/ Personal Interview (PI)/ or any other test/assessment as part of selection process:

- The Bank reserves its right to call for the GD/ PI, candidates in a state, at its sole discretion. Whenever online test is conducted, candidates shall be called for GD and/or PI on the basis of their performance in the online test.
- Candidates are required to obtain a minimum score in each test /section and also a minimum total score in the online test to be shortlisted for Group Discussion & or Interview. Candidates will be shortlisted for GD & or PI based on the number of vacancies, the cut-off criteria, and the total marks obtained in the online examination, as determined by the Bank prior to the completion of the interview /selection process, scores obtained in the online examination will not be shared with the candidates shortlisted for interview.
- In case more than one candidate secure the cut off marks (section mark or cut off point), such candidates will be ranked according to their age in ascending order.
